

The Triangle North Granville Access Road Project will construct a new two-lane roadway through the Triangle North Granville Development Park in Granville County, North Carolina. The new road will be 2 miles long, starting at the end of the existing access roadway near Tabbs Creek Road and connecting to US-158.
