Opened in 1942, the Camp trained over 40,000 troops on a 40,000-acre military training facility for combat in the European and Pacific Theaters.

Bring a chair or stand along the parade route to view vintage military vehicles; presentations by military dignitaries and a Camp Butner historian will reflect on the Camp's history; visit reenactment camps; tour historic Camp Butner sites, and more.
