Butterfield Announces \$400,000 COVID-19 Recovery Assistance Funding Through CARES Act

I am glad to see that through the passage of the CARES Act, this EDA funding will go directly to the Kerr-Tar Regional Council of Governments to support the redevelopment and revitalization in the region to diversify and strengthen the economy during this difficult time."

Background:

The CARES Act, which passed the U.S. House of Representatives on March 26, 2020 and was signed into law on March 27, 2020, provides the EDA with \$1.5 billion for economic development assistance programs to help communities prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus.
