PROPOSED BUDGET FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022

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BUDGET MESSAGE

Date: May 27, 2021 TO: Board of Directors of the Kerr-Tar Regional Council of Governments

In accordance with the N.C. Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control Act, the proposed COG budget for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021, is presented for your consideration. The COG Executive Committee has reviewed the proposed budget and recommends its adoption.

The Public Hearing on the Budget will be held Thursday, June 24, 2021 at 6:30PM at the Kerr-Tar Regional Council of Governments, 1724 Graham Avenue, Henderson NC.

COG Programs to be continued next year include: Economic Development Administration, Kerr-Tar Regional Economic Development Corporation, Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, Area Agency on Aging, Revolving Loan Fund, Micro Loan Fund, CARES Act Revolving Loan Fund, Housing and Community Development, Planning and Technical Assistance, Region K Community Assistance Corporation, and the Rural Transportation Planning Organization.

Major changes in the proposed budget for FY 2021/2022 include:

1. Salaries approved by the Executive Committee for FY 2021/2022 include a 3% COLA increase.

- 2. Kerr-Tar COG is proud to host a Fellow next year through NC LEAD, a program in partnership with the School of Government, NCLM and NCACC to get young, diverse graduates engaged in public service. The Fellow will work in the planning department assisting with implementation of strategies identified in the Kerr-Tar Regional Food Policy and projects that support our member governments.
- 3. Personnel changes with the recommended budget include an additional staff position. The Workforce Strategic Initiatives Coordinator's main job duties will include the development of new public and private workforce grant opportunities and the development and coordination of local reentry councils.
- 4. Fringe Benefits Rate recommended is 40.1134% and includes FICA, group insurance, retirement, 401k contributions, unemployment, and retiree benefits.
- 5. The Indirect Cost Rate recommended for FY 2021/2022 is approximately 43.8551% for Administrative Indirect and 13.5362% for Programmatic Indirect.
- 6. Member Assessments (dues) for member governments are recommended to remain unchanged at \$0.64 per capita. Member assessments are calculated on the population of municipalities and on the unincorporated population of county government members based on upon Census figures released in March, 2011.
- 7. Fund balance proposed to balance the FY 2021/2022 budget is zero.

Technical assistance and resource development for member governments continues to be the top priority for your staff. All COG members are encouraged to utilize the expertise of the COG staff for projects. The Kerr-Tar Regional Council of Governments is an extension of all of our members and serves as a valuable resource for many projects in the region.

The proposed budget for FY 2021/2022, as recommended by the COG Executive Committee, is within the resources of your Council of Governments.
